Years ago at a KW Right to Life event, a young woman said to me: 'I don't believe in your stand against abortion but I would defend to the death your right to express it.'

The young woman's realization of the Canadian Charter - Rights and Freedoms is accurate as it says in the Charter: 2. (b) freedom of thought, belief, opinion and expression including freedom of the press and other media communication - A most precious right in any country is the freedom of speech and expression and many refugees around the world are fleeing countries that do not have it.

Canada has been challenged in past years with regard to this very right on campus that now has a new free speech policy from the Ontario Government.

During the prolife challenge last year with prayerful witness in front of Freeport Hospital Kitchener ON, a local abortion centre, one director from the hospital said smugly, to me, 'You can pray but not in front of the hospital.' Prolife people are still praying in front of the hospital.

Court rulings in favour of reporting Ontario abortion statistics and allowing anti-abortion advertising is proof that the democratic process still works in Canada even though there is great resistance by some to suppress the anti-abortion message.

This is the Canadian Charter and this is what we believe. We will never give up our rights and freedom!
