C-14 Interview with an MP

Interview with Liberal MP for Kitchener Centre Raj Saini re. Life Issues Abortion and Euthanasia Interviewers: Bill and Odessa Barrett, Jane Richard

Question: Would you be willing to put any limitations on Abortion? (i.e. only in the first two trimesters) At this moment there are no limitations. Answer: "I am not concerned about that."

Euthanasia - We the interviewers believe it is always wrong. God is the author of life...."Thou shall not kill."
BILL - C14 proposed by the Liberal Government is going to allow Euthanasia under certain circumstances.
We want to know what safe-

guards should be put in place to protect vulnerable individuals (the disabled, the sick or the dying who don't want to be killed). We want to know that the conscience rights for healthcare workers and institutions will be respected. (i.e. Christian Hospitals whose beliefs don't permit people to be Euthanized) Question: Did you know about the long tradition in the Liberal Party of letting the MP's vote according to their conscience on moral issues?

In the recent past Justin Trudeau changed that by forcing Liberal MP's to vote for Abortion, even if it was against their conscience to do so. Since that change, a long Liberal tradition had crossed a line. We told Mr. Saini that

Answer: He said he did not

know that

this action was dictatorial. He tried to say that the Liberals are allowed to change their policy. If voters do not like it, they can vote for another party. He said that the people who voted Liberal did so because they agreed with the Liberal's Abortion Policy.

Question: When you vote for a party does that mean you agree with all of their

policies? Answer: NO! On balance vou vote for this party because you like some of their policies, but rarely all of them. So in this Mr. Saini was not telling the truth. The reason the Liberals (and other parties) allowed MP's to vote their conscience on moral issues for over a 100 years was because it was thought to be wrong to ask a man/woman to violate their conscience. Why? If you pressured someone to

violate their conscience, to vote in favour of something they believed was really wrong, then you bend or break their conscience. It is not as Saini says just "a change in policy". Then it becomes a totally different thing all together. This is changing the very nature of the men and women you want to represent us as your

We discussed a very good article on this by **Barbara Kay in the June 8, 2016 edition of the National Post.** I highly recommend it.
She talked about Bill C-14, the Liberal Government's Bill

on Euthanasia. She referenced an article by Andrew Coyne from the week before. Coyne referenced a new book titled "It's not that Simple: Euthanasia and Assisted Suicide Today", by Palliative Care researchers Ian Gentles and Jean Echlin. This book is available at the KPL and in book stores.

In Kay's article she mentions abuses that have occurred more and more in Belgium and Holland as time went on. Saini responded that as a Pharmacist, I know that the doctors and pharmacists in this country are good and will do the right thing. We were all in shock. We have read recently about a doctor who was put in jail for sexually abusing women patients while they were anaesthetized. Saini's statement was absurd, thrown at us as a justification for the lack of safeguards against abuse in the Liberal Bill C-14 concerning Euthanasia.

Jane questioned him over some of his statements. He got very loud and talked over her, just repeating why he thought this was such a good Bill

I have to say the three of us left very exasperated with Saini's: not listening, talking over us, telling us to vote for somebody else. His tone seemed condescending. I thought that as an MP, he is supposed to be a servant to the public and listen to them.





Practicing NFP takes self-control, trust in one's spouse, trust in God, honest and open communication, and a willingness to sacrifice for each other. But love is not harmed by these things. Because practicing NFP nurtures some of the very virtues that make for a successful marriage, far from damaging marriage, I believe it encourages couples to grow closer in unity!"
